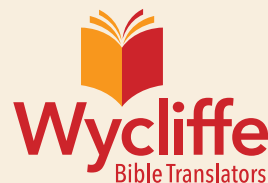

WYCLIFFE have a number of flexible options to work in a time frame, location and ministry that suits you. There are opportunities for you to get involved in helping to make God's Word available to people in a language that speaks to their hearts.

What's involved in an internship?

A flexible program to fit your situation -

- Australia or overseas
- up to two years
- usually part-time
- explore cross-cultural mission service
- be mentored in your personal growth
- Deepen your understanding of Bible translation
- Usually unpaid, but if necessary, training for financial support raising can be incorporated in the internship.

Possible internship options

A. Regional Team *(part-time)*

Join a one-year part-time internship in Australia as part of a Wycliffe Australia Regional team.

This would be ideally suited for someone studying part-time, living in any capital or regional city where Wycliffe teams are located, who was wanting to explore missions.

Service could involve participating in Wycliffe programs and events, connecting with local churches and using your gifts to **share the vision for Bible translation**.

B. Scripture Engagement Worker

in Papua New Guinea, or some other suitable location *(fulltime for up to 2 years)*.

Experience what is involved in helping people engage with the Bible in their own language! You would have opportunities to be involved in helping to run courses like the SALT (Scripture Application, Leadership Training) course, or working with a translation team in **Scripture Engagement** activities. The role would be based at an operational centre such as Ukarumpa, Papua New Guinea.

Preparation for this role includes the six-week Launch language learning program at SIL Australia and attending a finance support raising workshop. followed by pre-field orientation that incorporates cultural awareness and basic language learning (such as *Tok Pisin* for PNG).

C. Other Tailored Options

Wycliffe will work with you to design a program that suits the hours that work for you in a location and ministry that will best suit your needs.

The internship program is unpaid, as are the roles workers take on when they are accepted into membership with Wycliffe Australia. Training and assistance in raising prayer and financial support can be incorporated into the Internship. This may be particularly necessary for the costs of any overseas component.
