Linguist-translators - PEV (Plain English Version)

The Plain English Version (PEV) Mini-Bible was dedicated at the Katherine Christian Convention in May 2023. This new version is an easy-to-read English translation of the Bible, specifically designed for speakers of Indigenous Australian languages. The Mini-Bible is helpful for theological training and for translating the Bible into Indigenous Australian languages. It includes most of the New Testament and portions of the Old Testament... but there is still more of it to be translated into plain English. Wycliffe Australia's partner organisation, the Australian Society for Indigenous Languages (AuSIL), is in need of more translators to complete the whole Bible. Could this be you?

Sociolinguistic Research - Language Survey Workers

Before a language development project can begin, work needs to take place to investigate the viability of the translation and the needs of a language community.

Effective language development requires a clear understanding of the sociolinguistic environment and the means to assess the effectiveness of language development activities.

We are looking for people to research current and future patterns of language use, in order to understand translation needs for particular groups. You may be working alone using secondary resources, or also doing research directly with Indigenous language speakers.
