

Worldwide Wycliffe

(formerly Getting Insight)

Worldwide Wycliffe is the first of three Wycliffe member orientation workshops. This initial course includes organisational information that will assist new members in preparation of the second workshop, Partnership Development. In addition, Worldwide Wycliffe gives significant time to personal growth topics that introduce resilient living practices, which are explored more in the final course, Ready, Set...Thrive.

Worldwide Wycliffe course topics

1. History of Bible translation
2. Organisational structure and ethos
3. Introduction to Wycliffe Australia National staff and departments
4. Introduction to SILA
5. Insight into the latest translation, literacy and Scripture engagement trends
6. Multi-cultural teamwork and personal resiliency
7. Regional office resources
